FAITHFUL NAVIGATOR'S MESSAGE

Sir Knights,

I attended the Memorial Mass in West on Sunday, the 21st, after receiving an email from our Supreme Fourth Degree Master in New Haven asking for all Sir Knights who were able to attend the services. 110 Sir Knights attended the mass with most from the Austin and Dallas Districts. We had two or three Sir Knights attending from our District 1. The turnout consisted of as many red capes as white, yellow, and purple capes. The State Treasurer, Secretary, and Advocate were there also.

It was an emotional mass with Bishop Joseph Vasquez from the Austin Diocese comparing Christ's crucifixion and death to the suffering that occurred in West this last week. They had 14 die, over 200 injured, and so many unable to return to their homes as a result of the blast. My wife said she saw so many of the parishioners crying after receiving communion at the mass.

Five of those deaths were knights who were first responders to the fire that preceded the explosion. Many of the residents who live in the north side of the town were not yet able to go back to their houses to see what was damaged and if their houses were even there. A town council member provided the parish with the current status of who and when residents could return to their homes to pick up their belongings and to come back out. The police had all of the streets blocked to that part of town.

In addition to the Bishop, the Past District Master, the Faithful Navigator, and the Commander from the West Assembly and Council gave emotional speeches both before and after the mass in thanking all of the Sir Knights who attended the turnout and for all of the help that the Knights have already offered. They stated that both representatives from Supreme and our state council arrived earlier that week with checks to help in the recovery. They also mentioned that they were having their meeting the night of the explosion, and just six minutes before the start of their meeting, they all heard a loud blast. Realizing what had happened, they all left to assist in getting the residents and elderly from the houses and retirement community that were close to the plant without hesitation to what could happen to them.

This is just another example of what our Knights can do to aid each other in times of disaster.
