Fr Franklin Simmons passed on to his eternal reward on August 9th, 2014.

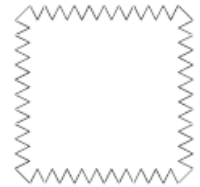


