Sir Knights,

If you were at previous meetings, you know that our annual income has been declining over the years mainly due to the movement of different councils away from the Wilhelm Assembly to other newly created assemblies. Subsequently, we are going to have to rely on each of you who are getting this newsletter to help us raise the funds that we need to pay for the things that we provide to our assembly members and families, i.e., the monthly usage of meeting rooms in the Cathedral Centre, dinners before each monthly assembly meeting, the printing and mailing of our newsletters to those brothers who do not have Internet access, our annual Christmas and Awards Parties, and the chalices for the families of those brothers who pass away each year. 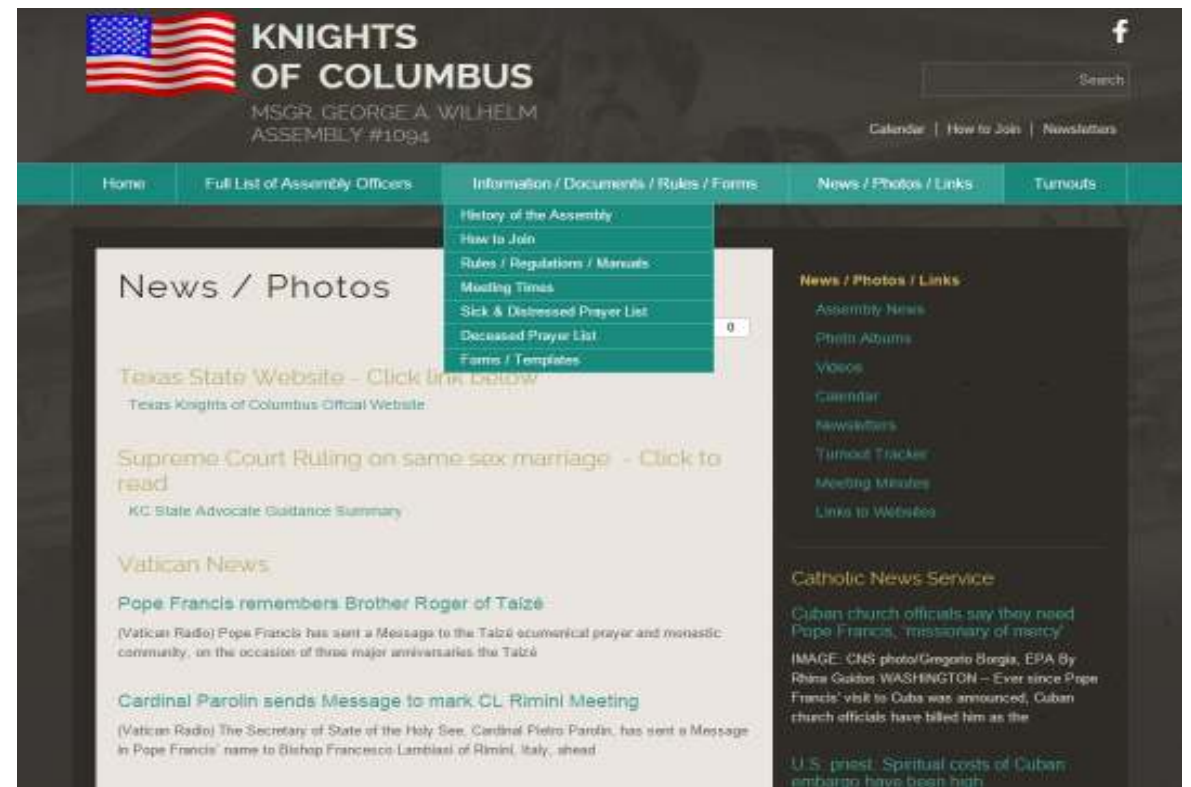
